- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Procurement Code is amended by
- 5 changing Section 50-30 as follows:
- 6 (30 ILCS 500/50-30)
- 7 Sec. 50-30. Revolving door prohibition on or after
- 8 <u>January 15, 1999</u>. Chief procurement officers, associate
- 9 procurement officers, State purchasing officers, their
- 10 designees whose principal duties are directly related to
- 11 State procurement, and executive officers confirmed by the
- 12 Senate are expressly prohibited for a period of 2 years after
- 13 terminating an affected position from engaging in any
- 14 procurement activity relating to the State agency most
- 15 recently employing them in an affected position for a period
- of at least 6 months. The prohibition includes but is not
- 17 limited to: lobbying the procurement process; specifying;
- 18 bidding; proposing bid, proposal, or contract documents; on
- 19 their own behalf or on behalf of any firm, partnership,
- 20 association, or corporation. This Section applies only to
- 21 persons who terminate an affected position on or after
- 22 January 15, 1999.
