- 1 AN ACT in relation to public aid.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by
- 5 changing Section 5-1 as follows:
- 6 (305 ILCS 5/5-1) (from Ch. 23, par. 5-1)
- 7 Sec. 5-1. Declaration of purpose. It is the purpose of
- 8 this Article to provide a program of essential medical care
- 9 and rehabilitative services for persons receiving basic
- 10 maintenance grants under this Code and for other persons who
- 11 are unable, because of inadequate resources, to meet their
- 12 essential medical needs.
- 13 Preservation of health, alleviation of sickness, and
- 14 correction of handicapping conditions for persons requiring
- 15 maintenance support are essential if those persons they are
- to have an opportunity to become self-supporting or to attain
- 17 a greater capacity for self-care. For persons who are
- 18 medically indigent but otherwise able to provide themselves
- 19 with a livelihood, it is of special importance to maintain
- 20 their incentives for continued independence and preserve
- 21 their limited resources for ordinary maintenance needs to
- 22 prevent their total or substantial dependency.
