AN ACT in relation to public aid.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by 5 changing Section 5-1 as follows:

6 (305 ILCS 5/5-1) (from Ch. 23, par. 5-1)

7 Sec. 5-1. Declaration of purpose. It is the purpose of 8 this Article to provide a program of essential medical care 9 and rehabilitative services for persons receiving basic 10 maintenance grants under this Code and for other persons who 11 are unable, because of inadequate resources, to meet their 12 essential medical needs.

Preservation of health, alleviation of sickness, 13 and correction of handicapping conditions for persons requiring 14 15 maintenance support are essential if those persons they are to have an opportunity to become self-supporting or to attain 16 a greater capacity for self-care. For persons who are 17 medically indigent but otherwise able to provide themselves 18 with a livelihood, it is of special importance to maintain 19 their incentives for continued independence and preserve 20 their limited resources for ordinary maintenance needs to 21 22 prevent their total or substantial dependency.
