- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Statute on Statutes is amended by adding
- 5 Section 1.36 as follows:
- 6 (5 ILCS 70/1.36 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 1.36. Born-alive infant.</u>
- 8 (a) In determining the meaning of any statute or of any
- 9 <u>rule</u>, <u>regulation</u>, <u>or interpretation</u> <u>of the various</u>
- 10 <u>administrative agencies of this State, the words "person",</u>
- 11 "human being", "child", and "individual" include every infant
- 12 <u>member of the species homo sapiens who is born alive at any</u>
- 13 <u>stage of development.</u>
- (b) As used in this Section, the term "born alive", with
- 15 <u>respect to a member of the species homo sapiens, means the</u>
- 16 <u>complete expulsion or extraction from its mother of that</u>
- 17 member, at any stage of development, who after that expulsion
- 18 or extraction breathes or has a beating heart, pulsation of
- 19 the umbilical cord, or definite movement of voluntary
- 20 <u>muscles</u>, <u>regardless</u> of <u>whether the umbilical cord has been</u>
- 21 <u>cut and regardless of whether the expulsion or extraction</u>
- 22 <u>occurs as a result of natural or induced labor, cesarean</u>
- 23 <u>section</u>, or induced abortion.
- 24 (c) A live child born as a result of an abortion shall
- 25 <u>be fully recognized as a human person and accorded immediate</u>
- 26 <u>protection under the law.</u>
- 27 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 28 becoming law.
