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AN ACT concerning municipalities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by
adding Section 8-8-9.5 as follows:

6 (65 ILCS 5/8-8-9.5 new)

Sec. 8-8-9.5. Cicero audit committee. The Cicero Audit 7 Committee is created. The duties of the Committee are to 8 9 review the audit reports prepared under this Act and any other financial reports and documents, including management 10 letters, prepared by or on behalf of the Town of Cicero. No 11 later than February 1 of each year, the Committee shall 12 report to the Governor and to the members of the General 13 Assembly regarding the financial reporting of the Town of 14 15 Cicero.

The Committee shall consist of 5 members appointed by the 16 Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate. The 17 18 appointments to the Committee must be made within 180 days after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 93rd 19 20 General Assembly. No more than 2 members of the Committee may be residents of the Town of Cicero. The members of the 21 22 Committee shall serve without compensation but may be reimbursed for their reasonable expenses related to their 23 24 service on the Committee.

The corporate authorities of the Town of Cicero must provide any information or documents to the Committee that the Committee deems necessary in carrying out its duties under this Section.
