- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by
- 5 adding Section 8-8-9.5 as follows:
- 6 (65 ILCS 5/8-8-9.5 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 8-8-9.5. Cicero audit committee. The Cicero Audit</u>
- 8 <u>Committee is created. The duties of the Committee are to</u>
- 9 review the audit reports prepared under this Act and any
- 10 <u>other financial reports and documents, including management</u>
- 11 <u>letters</u>, <u>prepared</u> by or on behalf of the Town of Cicero. No
- 12 <u>later than February 1 of each year, the Committee shall</u>
- 13 report to the Governor and to the members of the General
- 14 Assembly regarding the financial reporting of the Town of
- 15 <u>Cicero</u>.
- The Committee shall consist of 5 members appointed by the
- 17 Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate. The
- 18 appointments to the Committee must be made within 180 days
- 19 after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 93rd
- 20 <u>General Assembly. No more than 2 members of the Committee</u>
- 21 <u>may be residents of the Town of Cicero. The members of the</u>
- 22 <u>Committee shall serve without compensation but may be</u>
- 23 <u>reimbursed</u> by the Town of Cicero for their reasonable
- 24 <u>expenses related to their service on the Committee.</u>
- 25 <u>The corporate authorities of the Town of Cicero must</u>
- 26 provide any information or documents to the Committee that

- 29 <u>The Town of Cicero may not regulate its finances in a</u>
- 30 <u>manner inconsistent with the provisions of this Section.</u>
- 31 This Section is a limitation under subsection (i) of Section

- 1 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution on the
- 2 <u>concurrent</u> exercise by home rule units of powers and
- 3 <u>functions exercised by the State.</u>
- 4 This Section is repealed on February 15, 2006.
- 5 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 6 becoming law.
