- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by
- 5 changing Section 11-74.4-10 as follows:
- 6 (65 ILCS 5/11-74.4-10) (from Ch. 24, par. 11-74.4-10)
- 7 Sec. 11-74.4-10. <u>Revenues</u>. Revenues received by the
- 8 municipality from any property, building or facility owned,
- 9 leased or operated by the municipality or any agency or
- 10 authority established by the municipality may be used to pay
- 11 redevelopment project costs, or reduce outstanding
- 12 obligations of the municipality incurred under this Division
- 13 for redevelopment project costs. The municipality may place
- 14 such revenues in the special tax allocation fund which shall
- 15 be held by the municipal treasurer or other person designated
- 16 by the municipality. Revenue received by the municipality
- 17 from the sale or other disposition of real property acquired
- 18 by the municipality with the proceeds of obligations funded
- 19 by tax increment allocation financing shall be deposited by
