- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Election Code is amended by adding
- 5 Section 1A-20 as follows:
- 6 (10 ILCS 5/1A-20 new)
- 7 Sec. 1A-20. Grace period. Notwithstanding any other
- 8 provision of this Code to the contrary, beginning January 1,
- 9 2005, an election authority may establish procedures, in
- 10 <u>accordance</u> with rules adopted by the State Board of
- 11 <u>Elections, for the registration of voters during the period</u>
- 12 from the close of registration for a primary or election and
- 13 until the 14th day before the primary or election. During
- 14 this grace period, an unregistered qualified elector may
- 15 register to vote in person in the office or the election
- 16 <u>authority or at a voter registration location specifically</u>
- 17 <u>designated for this purpose by the election authority of the</u>
- 18 jurisdiction in which the applicant resides. A registered
- 19 voter may submit a change of address form during this period
- 20 <u>as well. The election authority shall register that</u>
- 21 <u>individual in the manner provided by law.</u>
- 22 <u>The State Board of Elections shall adopt necessary rules</u>
- 23 <u>for election authorities in the development of procedures</u>
- 24 <u>under this Section.</u>
