SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

65 ILCS 5/11-12-5.5 new

Amends the Illinois Municipal Code. Authorizes the corporate authorities of any municipality to create a schedule for and to collect developer donation fees for certain impacts specifically and uniquely attributable to the development of any subdivision or resubdivision of land within the municipality. Effective immediately.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by adding
- 5 Section 11-12-5.5 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 11-12-5.5. Developer donations. The corporate
- 8 <u>authorities of any municipality may create a schedule for and</u>
- 9 to collect developer donation fees for any impact on the
- 10 municipality's public infrastructure, services, operations, or
- 11 schools if that impact is specifically and uniquely
- 12 <u>attributable to the development of any subdivision or</u>
- resubdivision of land within the municipality.

- 15 becoming law.
