

## 93RD GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2003 and 2004 SB2178

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

430 ILCS 65/13.3

Amends the Firearm Owners Identification Card Act. Provides that it is an affirmative defense to a violation of a municipal ordinance that regulates the acquisition, possession, sale, or transfer of firearms that the municipality has failed to submit a copy of that ordinance to the Department of State Police. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT in relation to firearms.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Firearm Owners Identification Card Act is amended by changing Section 13.3 as follows:
- 6 (430 ILCS 65/13.3)
- Sec. 13.3. Municipal ordinance submission; affirmative defense.
- (a) Within 6 months after the effective date of this 9 amendatory Act of the 92nd General Assembly, every municipality 10 must submit to the Department of State Police a copy of every 11 12 ordinance adopted by the municipality that regulates the acquisition, possession, sale, or transfer of firearms within 13 14 the municipality and must submit, 30 days after adoption, every 15 such ordinance adopted after its initial submission of ordinances under this Section. The Department of State Police 16 17 shall compile these ordinances and publish them in a form 18 available to the public free of charge and shall periodically 19 update this compilation of ordinances in a manner prescribed by 20 the Director of State Police.
- 21 (b) It is an affirmative defense to a violation of a
  22 municipal ordinance that regulates the acquisition,
  23 possession, sale, or transfer of firearms that the municipality
  24 has failed to submit a copy of that ordinance to the Department
  25 of State Police.
