1 AN ACT in relation to criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by changing

 Section 2-5 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/2-5) (from Ch. 38, par. 2-5)
- 7 Sec. 2-5. "Conviction".
- 8 "Conviction" means a judgment of conviction or \underline{a} sentence
- 9 entered upon a plea of guilty or upon a verdict or finding of
- 10 guilty of an offense, rendered by a legally constituted jury or
- 11 by a court of competent jurisdiction authorized to try the case
- 12 without a jury.
