SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

410 ILCS 47/13 new

Amends the Poison Control System Act. Directs the Department of Public Health and the Illinois Poison Advisory Board to conduct a study to determine the feasibility of establishing a formula that sets State goals for funding the poison control system. Requires completion of the study by December 31, 2005. Effective immediately.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning public health.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Poison Control System Act is amended by adding Section 13 as follows:
- 6 (410 ILCS 47/13 new)
- 7 Sec. 13. Funding; study. To ensure the stability of funding for the Illinois Poison Control System, the Department of 8 Public Health and the Illinois Poison Advisory Board shall 9 conduct a study to determine the feasibility of establishing a 10 formula that sets State goals for funding the System. As part 11 of the study, the Department of Public Health and the Illinois 12 Poison Advisory Board shall consider the adoption of a formula 13 of funding for the Illinois Poison Control System that 14 15 establishes a minimum threshold of funding set on a per capita basis. Also, as part of the study, the Department of Public 16 Health and the Illinois Poison Advisory Board shall consider 17 the feasibility of implementing a separate source of funding 18 19 for the Illinois Poison Control System separate from the General Revenue Fund. The Department of Public Health and the 20 Illinois Poison Advisory Board shall complete the study by 21 December 31, 2005 and shall present their findings to the 22 Illinois General Assembly for its consideration. 23
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
