The following named amounts, or so much of 20 those amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the 21 22 objects and purposes names, are appropriated to the Office of 23 the State Appellate Defender for expenses related to federally assisted programs to work on systemic sentencing 24 issues appeals cases to which the agency is appointed, 25 provide statewide training and services to Illinois Public 26 Defenders, and to enhance the capability of public defenders 27 28 in rural counties to effectively represent their clients in 29 appropriate cases, making available to them expert witnesses 30 and investigative services.

5 Section 20. The amount of \$3,133,476, or so much of that 6 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital 7 Litigation Trust Fund to the Office of the State Appellate 8 Defender for expenses incurred in providing assistance to 9 trial attorneys under item (c) (5) of Section 10 of the State 10 Appellate Defender Act.

Section 25. The amount of \$157,000, or so much of that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Expungement Program.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2004.".
