AN ACT concerning criminal identification.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Criminal Identification Act is amended bychanging Section 1 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 2630/1) (from Ch. 38, par. 206-1)

Sec. 1. The Department of State Police hereinafter referred
to as the "Department", is hereby empowered to cope with the
task of criminal identification and investigation.

10 The Director of the Department of State Police shall, from 11 time to time, appoint such employees or assistants as may be 12 necessary to carry out this work. Employees or assistants so 13 appointed shall receive salaries subject to the standard pay 14 plan provided for in the "Personnel Code", approved July 18, 15 1955, as amended.
