1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The I-FLY Act is amended by changing Section 5
- 5 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 3958/5)
- 7 Sec. 5. Findings. The General Assembly finds that, in order
- 8 to create, retain, and stabilize reliable air service to
- 9 commercial service airports outside of Cook County, improve
- 10 accessibility to business and industrial centers, augment
- 11 <u>Illinois'</u> the State's tourism industry, and encourage the
- 12 development of facilities and support initiatives for
- 13 community growth, cooperation between the State, airports, and
- 14 communities is essential. The General Assembly further finds
- that a State grant program is the best method to achieve these
- 16 ends.
