## 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by changing
Section 12-21.6 as follows:

6 (720 ILCS 5/12-21.6)

Sec. 12-21.6. Endangering the life or health of a child.

8 (a) It is unlawful for any person to willfully cause or 9 permit the life or health of a child under the age of 18 to be 10 endangered or to willfully cause or permit a child to be placed 11 in circumstances that endanger the child's life or health, 12 except that it is not unlawful for a person to relinquish a 13 child in accordance with the Abandoned Newborn Infant 14 Protection Act.

15 (b) There is a rebuttable presumption that a person 16 committed the offense if he or she left a child 6 years of age 17 or younger unattended in a motor vehicle for more than 10 18 minutes.

19 (b-5) There is a rebuttable presumption that a person committed the offense if he or she permits a child of which 20 21 that person is the parent or legal guardian, or a child that he or she is caring for with the permission of the parent or legal 22 guardian of that child, to be present or remain at a location 23 where any act takes place that is chargeable as a Class 2 24 felony or greater under the Illinois Controlled Substances Act 25 26 or the Cannabis Control Act.

(c) "Unattended" means either: (i) not accompanied by a
person 14 years of age or older; or (ii) if accompanied by a
person 14 years of age or older, out of sight of that person.

30 (d) A violation of this Section is a Class A misdemeanor.
 31 except that a violation of this Section is a Class 4 felony if
 32 the conditions described in subsection (b-5) are present. A

second or subsequent violation of this Section is a Class 3 felony. A violation of this Section that is a proximate cause of the death of the child is a Class 3 felony for which a person, if sentenced to a term of imprisonment, shall be sentenced to a term of not less than 2 years and not more than 10 years.
