AN ACT making appropriations and reappropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof may be necessary, respectively, for the objects 5 as and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the General 6 Revenue Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois 7 University to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of 8 9 Southern Illinois University, including payment or reimbursement to the University for personal services and 10 related costs, incurred during the fiscal year ending June 11 30, 2005: 12 For Personal Services, including payment to the University 13 14 for personal services costs incurred during the fiscal year\$184,218,300 15 For State Contributions to Social 16 Security, for Medicare2,445,200 17 18 19 For Commodities1,445,600 20 21 22 23 24 25 For Southern Illinois Collegiate 26 Total \$216,703,700 27 28

29 Section 10. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as 30 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 31 Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois University 32 for all costs required to match the Federal Title II Teacher SB3227

The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as 6 Section 15. may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 7 Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois University 8 for all costs required to match the Federal Title II Teacher 9 Quality Enhancement State Grant for Southern Illinois 10 11 University-Edwardsville, including payment to the University for personal services and related costs incurred, for the 12 fiscal year ending June 30, 2005. 13

Section 20. The sum of \$800,000, or so much thereof as 15 16 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of business on June 30, 2004, from a reappropriation heretofore 17 made for such purpose in Article 4, Section 65 of Public Act 18 93-587, is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund 19 to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois University for 20 the purchase of equipment for Altgeld Hall and the Old 21 Baptist Foundation Building at Southern Illinois University-22 Carbondale. 23

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,25 2004.
