## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Department of Labor for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004 as follows:

General Funds \$5,894,750
Other State Funds \$157,700
Total \$6,052,450
