WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the State of Illinois learned with regret of the death of Dr. James R. McAnelly on

5 WHEREAS, Dr. McAnelly was born on March 16, 1932, in 6 Bloomington to Clyde and Virginia (Jett) McAnelly; he was 7 educated at Mooseheart and was on the 1950 undefeated football 8 team; during his senior year, he was awarded All-State in 9 football; he was a member of the Hall of Fame at Mooseheart; 10 and

WHEREAS, Dr. McAnelly received a B.S. degree from the University of Colorado, Boulder, where he received an athletic scholarship for football; he received a master's degree and Ed.D. degree from Northern Illinois University, DeKalb; and

WHEREAS, Dr. McAnelly was one of the founding teachers at Waubonsee Community College (WCC), Sugar Grove, where he taught business for 30 years; in addition to teaching at WCC, he was a foreign studies director, and led groups to the United Kingdom, Europe, and China; he also taught at Northern Illinois University at DeKalb, East Aurora High School, and Haines Junior High School in St. Charles; and

WHEREAS, Dr. McAnelly was the author of two college "Business Mathematics for College" textbooks, and "Fundamentals of Retailing", which are in the Library of Congress; he was a member of Delta Pi Epsilon and was listed in "Who's Who in American Law" in 1985; for 30 years, he was an IHSA certified swimming official and did most of officiating at Marmion Academy; he was an Eagle Scout; he played the euphonium for the American Legion for many years; after retiring from teaching, he taught discus for the track team at Holy Angels School for three years; and
