WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate were saddened to learn of the death of Dr. Peter J. McFarlane of Godfrey on May 18, 2004; and

5 WHEREAS, Peter McFarlane was born Jan. 27, 1918, in Moline 6 the son of the late John and Cora (Davis) McFarlane; he married 7 the former Bertha Lucille Biondolino on December 26, 1942, at 8 the former St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Alton; and

9 WHEREAS, A longtime Alton area physician, he was a graduate 10 of Marquette Catholic High School, Shurtleff College, and the 11 University of Illinois Medical School; he served his internship 12 at St. Margaret's Hospital in Hammond, Indiana, and his 13 residency at Fitzsimmons Hospital in Denver, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, Dr. McFarlane served his country in the United States Army Medical Corps during World War II and began his Alton medical practice in 1952, retiring in 1984; he served as chief of obstetrics and chief of staff at the former St. Joseph's Hospital in Alton and remained as a medical consultant at St. Anthony's until 2000; and

WHEREAS, He was a longtime member of the former St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Alton and St. Ambrose Catholic Church in Godfrey; he was also a member of the American College of Obstetrics and Gynecology and a diplomate of the American Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology; and

25 WHEREAS, Dr. McFarlane was devoted to his family; in his 26 spare time he enjoyed carpentry, reading, and dancing; and
