SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$500,000 from the General Revenue Fund to the Historic Preservation Grant Fund. Appropriates \$500,000 from the Historic Preservation Grant Fund to the Illinois Historic Preservation Agency for the purposes of the Historic Preservation Grant Program as provided in the Illinois Historic Preservation Act. Effective July 1, 2005.

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The sum of \$500,000, or so much of that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Historic Preservation Grant Fund for the purposes of the Historic Preservation Grant Fund.
- 8 Section 10. The sum of \$500,000, or so much of that 9 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Historic 10 Preservation Grant Fund to the Illinois Historic Preservation 11 Agency for the purposes of the Historic Preservation Grant 12 Program as provided in the Illinois Historic Preservation 13 Act.
- 14 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 15 1, 2005.
