1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 476

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 476, AS AMENDED,  
3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No.  
4 2, as follows:

5 on page 5, line 12, after the period, by inserting the  
6 following: "In the case of naming or sponsorship rights for a  
7 single event or a continuous series of related events, the  
8 administrator may grant multiple licenses not based on the  
9 standard of "highest and best" proposals if the end result is  
10 the most beneficial to the State."; and

11 on page 6, line 6, by replacing "highest and best proposal"  
12 with "to grant a license"; and

13 on page 7, line 7, before the period, by inserting the  
14 following: "except as provided in this subsection. The  
15 Executive Ethics Commission may adopt rules authorizing the  
16 administrator to grant licenses without pre-approval under  
17 subsection (f), but the rules must specify, by category, those  
18 emergency and other extenuating situations in which  
19 pre-approval is waived, must provide for prompt review by the  
20 Commission after the granting of the license, and may contain  
21 other provisions the Commission deems necessary to prevent  
22 abuse of this procedure"; and

1 on page 7, line 15, by replacing "\$10,000" with "\$25,000".
