# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Governor Transition Act is amended by 5 changing Section 1 as follows:

6 (15 ILCS 10/1) (from Ch. 127, par. 63b121)

7 Sec. 1. When at any general election for the the office of Governor the incumbent Governor is not elected, the Governor, 8 within 2 weeks after such election, shall provide space for not 9 more than 5 persons designated by the Governor-elect to enable 10 11 the Governor-elect to begin a review and analysis of budgeted expenditures during the then current biennium and budget 12 13 requests for the ensuing biennium and to acquire a working 14 knowledge of the various offices, departments, commissions, 15 boards and other agencies of the executive branch of the State The Governor shall cooperate with 16 government. the 17 Governor-elect and the staff so designated by him and provide any assistance that may be reasonably requested. 18
