SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/12-602

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that a vehicle of the first division may not be seized or impounded solely on the basis of a violation of the provision requiring prevention of excessive or unusual noise. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
- 5 Section 12-602 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/12-602) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 12-602)
- 7 Sec. 12-602. Mufflers, prevention of noise.
- 8 (a) Every motor vehicle driven or operated upon the
- 9 highways of this State shall at all times be equipped with an
- 10 adequate muffler or exhaust system in constant operation and
- 11 properly maintained to prevent any excessive or unusual noise.
- 12 No such muffler or exhaust system shall be equipped with a
- 13 cutout, bypass or similar device. No person shall modify the
- exhaust system of a motor vehicle in a manner which will
- 15 amplify or increase the noise of such vehicle above that
- 16 emitted by the muffler originally installed on the vehicle, and
- such original muffler shall comply with all the requirements of
- 18 this Section.
- 19 (b) A vehicle of the first division may not be seized or
- 20 impounded solely on the basis of a violation of this Section.
