## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

60 ILCS 1/5-15

Amends the Township Code. Requires that on the petition of 5% (now, 10%) or more of the local voters in the county, the county board shall submit to the voters the question of township organization. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Township Code is amended by changing Section
- 5 5-15 as follows:
- 6 (60 ILCS 1/5-15)
- 7 Sec. 5-15. Form of proposition. The county board, on the
- 8 petition of  $\frac{5\%}{10\%}$  or more of the legal voters of the county,
- 9 shall certify and cause to be submitted to the voters of the
- 10 county the question of township organization under this
- 11 Article. The proposition shall be substantially in the form:
- 12 "For township organization" or "Against township
- organization".

- 15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 16 becoming law.
