22 (b) The Chairman of the County Board of St. Clair County 23 shall appoint a commissioner for <u>each of</u> the <u>terms</u> term 24 expiring in January, 2004<u>, 2005, and 2006. The</u> and in the

following year the Chairman of the County Board of Madison 1 County shall appoint a commissioner for each of the terms term 2 3 expiring in January, 2007, 2008, and 2009 of that year. Successive appointments for terms expiring in January of each 4 year shall alternate each between the Chairman of the St. Clair 5 County Board and the Chairman of the Madison County Board for 6 7 periods of 3 years beginning with the Chairman of the St. Clair County Board, except as may be modified by the provisions of 8 subsection (c). 9

10 (c) In the event that a tax has been imposed in Monroe County consistent with the provisions of Section 5.01 of the 11 Local Mass Transit District Act, the Chairman of the Monroe 12 13 County Board shall, upon the expiration of the term of a 14 commissioner who is a resident of the County in which 3 of the 15 then remaining commissioners reside, appoint a commissioner with the advice and consent of the Monroe County Board. The 16 commissioner appointed by the Monroe County Board shall hold 17 18 office for a term of 5 years and a successor shall be appointed 19 by the chairman of the Monroe County Board, with the advice and 20 consent of the Monroe County Board. The appointments of the 4 21 remaining commissioners shall then be made by the County Board Chairman or his or her successor in office originally 22 appointing the term of the expiring commissioner continue to 23 24 alternate between St. Clair and Madison County so that each 25 County shall continue to retain the appointments of 2 26 commissioners. To the extent that this subsection (c) conflicts with any other provision of this Section or Section 3, the 27 28 provisions of this subsection (c) control. (Source: P.A. 93-432, eff. 6-1-04.) 29

commissioner, with the advice and consent of the respective 1 2 county board, for the unexpired term. During the balance of Any 3 vacancies occurring during the transition for the 4 implementation of this amendatory Act of the 93rd General 5 Assembly, terms of commissioners that were appointed by the Governor, and not by the respective County Board Chairmen, 6 7 shall be filled for the unexpired term in the following manner: for the term that according to subsection (a) of Section 2 is 8 scheduled to expire in January, 2005 but for whom the 9 10 appointment letter extended the term to January, 2008, such term shall expire in January, 2005 and shall be filled by the 11 appointment by the County Board Chairman of St. Clair Madison 12 County. Subsequent unexpired terms for if occurring in the 13 14 years 2004, 2006 and 2009 shall be appointed, or 2008 or by the 15 County Board Chairman of St. Clair County and the term expiring in 2007 shall be appointed by the County Board Chairman of 16 Madison County if occurring in the years 2005 or 2007, each 17 18 with the advice and consent of the respective county board.-(Source: P.A. 93-432, eff. 6-1-04; revised 10-29-04.)". 19
