## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Amends the Illinois Insurance Code. Makes a technical change in a Section relating to coverage of adopted children.

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by changing Section 356h as follows:
- 6 (215 ILCS 5/356h) (from Ch. 73, par. 968h)
- 7 Sec. 356h. No individual or group policy of accident and and health insurance which covers the insured's immediate 8 family or children, as well as covering the insured, shall 9 exclude a child from coverage or limit coverage for a child 10 11 solely because the child is an adopted child, or solely because the child does not reside with the insured. For purposes of 12 this Section, a child who is in the custody of the insured, 13 14 pursuant to an interim court order of adoption or, in the case 15 of group insurance, placement of adoption, whichever comes first, vesting temporary care of the child in the insured, is 16 17 an adopted child, regardless of whether a final order granting 18 adoption is ultimately issued.
