Amend House Bill 1945 by replacing 3 everything after the enacting clause with the following: "Section 5. The Higher Education Student Assistance Act is 4 5 amended by adding Section 39 as follows: (110 ILCS 947/39 new) 6 7 Sec. 39. Monetary Award Program Plus. (a) The Commission shall receive and consider applications 8 for monetary grant assistance under this Section to benefit 9 those students who are not eligible for Monetary Award Program 10 grants awarded in accordance with Section 35 of this Act, but 11 who will benefit from assistance in paying for the costs of 12 attendance at institutions of higher learning. Subject to a 13 separate appropriation for this purpose and sufficient revenue 14 from loan asset proceeds, an applicant is eligible for a 15 16 Monetary Award Program Plus grant under this Section if the Commission finds that the applicant meets all of the following 17 qualifications: 18 19 (1) He or she is a resident of this State and a citizen or permanent resident of the United States. 20 21 (2) He or she is enrolled at least half-time as a 22 sophomore, junior, or senior at a MAP-eligible institution, as defined under the Monetary Award Program. 23

(3) He or she is not eligible for a Monetary Award

- (4) He or she is from a family that had an adjusted gross income, listed on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid, of less than \$200,000 for 2005 taxes payable in calendar year 2006.
- (b) All grants under this Section are applicable only to 6 7 tuition and necessary fee costs. The Commission shall determine the grant amount for each student, which amount must not exceed 8 \$500 per year or \$250 per semester and must not exceed tuition 9 and necessary fees net of State and federal financial aid. 10
- (c) Grants under this Section may be awarded only for the 11 Fall 2006 and Spring 2007 semesters. 12
 - (d) The Commission shall pay Monetary Award Program Plus grant awards to eligible students by application date, on a first-come, first-served basis.
 - (e) The Commission, in determining the number of Monetary Award Program Plus grants to be awarded, shall utilize whatever appropriate data is available and shall notify applicants that grant assistance is contingent upon the availability of appropriated funds.
- 21 (f) The Commission shall determine if sufficient funds are 22 available from the sale of student loan assets or transaction processing to continue Monetary Award Program Plus beyond the 23 Spring 2007 semester and shall prepare a report for the 24 25 Governor and General Assembly indicating whether funding is 26 available and how it can be used to support the program.
- 27 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 28 2006.".
