AN ACT concerning regulation.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Banking Act is amended by changing
Section 3 as follows:

6 (205 ILCS 5/3) (from Ch. 17, par. 309)

7 Sec. 3. Formation and primary powers. It shall be lawful to form banks, as herein provided, for the the purpose of discount 8 9 and deposit, buying and selling exchange and doing a general banking business, excepting the issuing of bills to circulate 10 11 as money; and such banks shall have the power to loan money on personal and real estate security, and to accept and execute 12 trusts upon obtaining a certificate of authority pursuant to 13 the "Corporate Fiduciary Act", and shall be subject to all of 14 15 the provisions of this Act.
