1 AN ACT concerning business.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Credit Card Issuance Act is amended by changing Section 1a as follows:
- 6 (815 ILCS 140/1a) (from Ch. 17, par. 6002)
- Sec. 1a. No person may be denied a credit card, upon proper application therefor, solely on account of unlawful discrimination, as defined and and prohibited in Section 4-103 of the Illinois Human Rights Act. No question requesting any information concerning an applicant's marital status shall
- 12 appear on any credit card application except in connection with
- an application for a joint account.
