AN ACT concerning criminal law.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by changing
Section 33-5 as follows:

6 (720 ILCS 5/33-5)

7 Sec. 33-5. Preservation of evidence.

8 (a) It is unlawful for a law enforcement agency or an agent 9 acting on behalf of <u>the</u> the law enforcement agency to 10 intentionally fail to comply with the provisions of subsection 11 (a) of Section 116-4 of the Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963.

12 (b) Sentence. A person who violates this Section is guilty13 of a Class 4 felony.

14 (c) For purposes of this Section, "law enforcement agency"
15 has the meaning ascribed to it in subsection (e) of Section
16 116-4 of the Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963.
