Amends the Child Labor Law. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning meal periods.

1 AN ACT concerning employment.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Child Labor Law is amended by changing
- 5 Section 4 as follows:
- 6 (820 ILCS 205/4) (from Ch. 48, par. 31.4)
- 7 Sec. 4. No minor under sixteen (16) years of age shall be
- 8 employed, or permitted to work in any gainful occupations
- 9 mentioned in Section 1 of this Act for more than five (5) hours
- 10 continuously without an interval of at least thirty (30)
- 11 minutes for meal period, and and no period of less than thirty
- 12 (30) minutes shall be deemed to interrupt a continuous period
- of work.
