Amends the Clinical Psychologist Licensing Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the short title and policy of the Act.

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Clinical Psychologist Licensing Act is amended by changing Section 1 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 15/1) (from Ch. 111, par. 5351)
- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2007)
- Sec. 1. The $\frac{\text{The}}{\text{The}}$ practice of clinical psychology in Illinois 8 is hereby declared to affect the public health, safety and 9 welfare, and to be subject to regulations in the public 10 interest to protect the public from persons who are 11 unauthorized or unqualified to represent themselves 12 as clinical psychologists or as being able to render clinical 13 14 psychological services as herein defined, and from 15 unprofessional conduct by persons licensed to practice clinical psychology. This Act shall be known and may be cited 16 17 as the "Clinical Psychologist Licensing Act".
