## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 500/50-30

Amends the Illinois Procurement Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the revolving door prohibition.

1 AN ACT concerning finance.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Procurement Code is amended by changing Section 50-30 as follows:
- 6 (30 ILCS 500/50-30)
- 7 Sec. 50-30. Revolving door prohibition.
- 8 (a) Chief procurement officers, associate procurement officers, State purchasing officers, their designees whose 9 principal duties are directly related to State procurement, and 10 and executive officers confirmed by the Senate are expressly 11 prohibited for a period of 2 years after terminating an 12 affected position from engaging in any procurement activity 13 14 relating to the State agency most recently employing them in an 15 affected position for a period of at least 6 months. The prohibition includes but is not limited to: lobbying the 16 17 procurement process; specifying; bidding; proposing bid, proposal, or contract documents; on their own behalf or on 18 19 behalf of any firm, partnership, association, or corporation. 20 This subsection applies only to persons who terminate an
