1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Medical Practice Act of 1987 is amended by
5 changing Section 6 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 60/6) (from Ch. 111, par. 4400-6)

7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2007)

8 Sec. 6. It is declared to be the ~~the~~ public policy of this
9 State, pursuant to paragraphs (h) and (i) of Section 6 of
10 Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970, that any
11 power or function set forth in this Act to be exercised by the
12 State is an exclusive State power or function. Such power or
13 function shall not be exercised concurrently, either directly
14 or indirectly, by any unit of local government, including home
15 rule units, except as otherwise provided in this Act.
