2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Hearing Instrument Consumer Protection Act
is amended by changing Section 1 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 50/1) (from Ch. 111, par. 7401)

(Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2006)

Sec. 1. Purpose. The The purpose of this Act is to protect 8 the hearing-impaired public from incompetent and dishonest 9 10 dispensers of hearing instruments who could endanger the health, safety and welfare of the People of this State. The 11 Federal Food and Drug Administration has recommended that State 12 legislation is necessary in order to establish standards of 13 competency and to impose stringent penalties for those who 14 15 violate the public trust in this field of health care.
