## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Liquor Control Act of 1934 is amended by
- 5 changing Section 3-1 as follows:
- 6 (235 ILCS 5/3-1) (from Ch. 43, par. 97)
- 7 Sec. 3-1. There is hereby created an Illinois Liquor
- 8 Control Commission consisting of 7 members to be appointed by
- 9 the Governor with  $\underline{\text{the}}$  the advice and consent of the Senate, no
- 10 more than 4 of whom shall be members of the same political
- 11 party.
