Amends the Liquor Control Act of 1934. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning retail sales on Sundays.

1 AN ACT concerning liquor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Liquor Control Act of 1934 is amended by changing Section 6-14 as follows:
- 6 (235 ILCS 5/6-14) (from Ch. 43, par. 129)
- 7 Sec. 6-14. No person shall sell at retail any alcoholic liquor on Sundays unless authorized by general ordinance or 8 resolution of $\underline{\text{the}}$ the city council, president and board of 9 trustees or county board, as the case may be; provided, however 10 that the city council, president and board of trustees or 11 county board, as the case may be, may further restrict the 12 13 permissible hours for the sale of alcoholic liquors under such 14 licenses in its political subdivision as the public good and 15 convenience may require.
