Amends the Tax Increment Allocation Redevelopment Act in the Illinois Municipal Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning revenue.

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AN ACT concerning local government.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by 5 changing Section 11-74.4-10 as follows:

6 (65 ILCS 5/11-74.4-10) (from Ch. 24, par. 11-74.4-10)

7 Sec. 11-74.4-10. Revenues received by the the municipality from any property, building or facility owned, leased or 8 9 operated by the municipality or any agency or authority established by the municipality, or from repayments of loans, 10 may be used to pay redevelopment project costs, or reduce 11 12 outstanding obligations of the municipality incurred under Division for redevelopment project 13 this costs. The 14 municipality may place such revenues in the special tax 15 allocation fund which shall be held by the municipal treasurer or other person designated by the municipality. Revenue 16 17 received by the municipality from the sale or other disposition of real property acquired by the municipality with the proceeds 18 19 of obligations funded by tax increment allocation financing 20 shall be deposited by the municipality in the special tax allocation fund. 21
