Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning yielding the right of way.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
- 5 Section 11-902 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/11-902) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 11-902)
- 7 Sec. 11-902. Vehicle turning left. $\underline{\text{The}}$ $\underline{\text{The}}$ driver of a
- 8 vehicle intending to turn to the left within an intersection or
- 9 into an alley, private road, or driveway shall yield the
- 10 right-of-way to any vehicle approaching from the opposite
- 11 direction which is so close as to constitute an immediate
- 12 hazard, but said driver, having so yielded may proceed at such
- time as a safe interval occurs.
