Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Mental Health and Developmental
- 5 Disabilities Code is amended by changing Section 2-101 as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (405 ILCS 5/2-101) (from Ch. 91 1/2, par. 2-101)
- 8 Sec. 2-101. No recipient of services shall be presumed
- 9 legally disabled, nor shall such person be held legally
- 10 disabled except as determined by a court. Such determination
- shall be separate from a judicial proceeding held to determine
- 12 whether a person is subject to involuntary admission or meets
- 13 <u>the</u> the standard for judicial admission.
