The School Code is amended by adding Sections 4 10-20.40 and 34-18.33 as follows: 5 (105 ILCS 5/10-20.40 new)6 7 Sec. 10-20.40. Multiple-birth children; classroom placement. (a) For purposes of this Section, "higher-order multiples" 9 means triplets, quadruplets, quintuplets, or more. 10 (b) The school board shall allow a parent or guardian of 11 twins or higher-order multiples to request that the children be 12 placed in the same classroom or in separate classrooms if the 13 children are in the same grade level at the same school. The 14 school may recommend classroom placement to the parent or 15 16 guardian and provide professional educational advice to the parent or quardian to assist him or her in making the best 17 decision for the children's education. A school must provide 18 the placement requested by the parent or guardian, unless the 19 school board makes a classroom placement determination 20 21 following a principal's request under subsection (d) this Section. 22 (c) The parent or guardian must request classroom placement 23 under this Section no later than 14 days after the first day of 24
