18 WHEREAS, Mrs. Lancaster spent many years working as a nurse in the State of Illinois; she worked at University of Chicago 19 Hospitals, Ingalls Memorial Hospital, and at Christ Community 20 Hospital from 1961 until her retirement in 1987; at Christ 21 22 Community Hospital, now known as Advocate Christ Medical Center 23 in Oak Lawn, she worked as assistant supervisor of surgery, 24 operating room supervisor and clinical instruction 25 (Evangelical School of Nursing), and as director of surgical 26 services including operating room, recovery room, Surgi-Care 27 Center, and the surgical intensive care unit; and
