13 at Aurora Community College in Adult education, District 88
14 Adult Education classes on Starting a Small Business, State and
15 Division PTA seminars on Parliamentary Procedures, leadership
16 training to the State Kiwanis Organization, and she was a St.

29 Comprehensive Plan Commission, and as a library board member
