WHEREAS, He has published a book on Richard Steele and has written and presented numerous articles and papers; among honors he has received are a Teacher Appreciation Award from Sigma Tau Delta, the Distinguished Service Award for Administrative Professionals, and the Esprit de Corps Award for Administrative Professionals; and
