15 knock-out drill, Gerardo Rivera placed third, Maryra Monarez  
16 placed fourth, and Travis Schwab placed ninth; Joey Salgado  
17 placed first in the male sit up competition, and Amy Romero  
18 placed second in the female sit up competition; in the male  
19 push-up category, Rene Salgado earned seventh place, and Hector  
20 Moncanda received tenth place; and

21 WHEREAS, Winning the area championship title qualifies the  
22 team for the national competition in Pensacola, Florida; for  
23 the fourth year in a row, the team has earned this opportunity  
24 to compete with 24 other schools from throughout the nation for
