1 AN ACT concerning business.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business

 Practices Act is amended by changing Section 2 as follows:
- 6 (815 ILCS 505/2) (from Ch. 121 1/2, par. 262)
- 7 Sec. 2. Unfair methods of competition and and unfair or deceptive acts or practices, including but not limited to the 8 9 use or employment of any deception fraud, false pretense, false 10 promise, misrepresentation or the concealment, suppression or omission of any material fact, with intent that others rely 11 12 upon the concealment, suppression or omission of such material fact, or the use or employment of any practice described in 13 14 Section 2 of the "Uniform Deceptive Trade Practices Act", approved August 5, 1965, in the conduct of any trade or 15 commerce are hereby declared unlawful whether any person has in 16 17 fact been misled, deceived or damaged thereby. In construing 18 section consideration shall be given 19 interpretations of the Federal Trade Commission and the federal courts relating to Section 5 (a) of the Federal Trade 20 21 Commission Act.
