SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

210 ILCS 45/3-202.05 new

Amends the Nursing Home Care Act. Provides that no later than one year after the effective date of this amendatory Act, a nursing home must: (1) acquire at least one automated external defibrillator (AED); (2) ensure that the AED is tested and maintained; (3) arrange for training in cardio-pulmonary resuscitation and the use of the AED for employees of the nursing home; and (4) ensure that employees of the nursing home comply with certain provisions concerning the use of the AED.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Nursing Home Care Act is amended by adding
Section 3-202.05 as follows:

7 <u>Sec. 3-202.05. Automated external defibrillator required.</u>
8 <u>No later than one year after the effective date of this</u>
9 <u>amendatory Act of the 94th General Assembly, a facility must do</u>
10 <u>all of the following:</u>

11 (1) Acquire at least one automated external 12 defibrillator ("AED"), which shall be maintained in a 13 central location within the facility that shall be made 14 known and available to the employees of the facility.

15 <u>(2) Ensure that the AED is tested and maintained in</u> 16 <u>accordance with the Automated External Defibrillator Act,</u> 17 <u>and provide notification to the appropriate first aid,</u> 18 <u>ambulance or rescue squad, or other appropriate emergency</u> 19 <u>medical services provider regarding the AED, the type of</u> 20 <u>AED acquired, and its location in the facility.</u>

21 <u>(3) Arrange for training in cardio-pulmonary</u> 22 <u>resuscitation and the use of the AED for employees of the</u> 23 <u>facility in accordance with the Automated External</u> 24 <u>Defibrillator Act.</u>

25 <u>(4) Ensure that employees of the facility comply with</u>
 26 <u>any other rules of the Department concerning the use of the</u>
 27 <u>AED.</u>

As used in this Section, "automated external
 defibrillator" has the meaning attributed to that term in the
 Automated External Defibrillator Act.
