A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the
8 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois Criminal
9 Justice Information Authority:

21 Section 15. The sum of \$12,100,000, or so much thereof
 22 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal
 23 Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice
 24 Information Authority for awards and grants to state
 25 agencies.

26 Section 20. The following named sums, or so much thereof
 27 as needed, are appropriated to the Illinois Criminal Justice
 28 Information Authority for activities undertaken in support of
 29 federal assistance programs administered by units of state
 30 and local government and non-profit organizations:

4 Section 25. The following named amounts, or so much

7 and other monies received from federal agencies, from other
8 units of government, and from private/not-for-profit
9 organizations for activities undertaken in support of
10 investigating issues in criminal justice and for undertaking
11 other criminal justice information projects:

5 Section 35. The sum of \$40,000,000, or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal
7 Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice
8 Information Authority for awards and grants to state agencies
9 and units of local government, to include operational
10 activities and programs undertaken by the Authority, in
11 support of Federal Crime Bill Initiatives.

12 Section 40. The sum of \$12,540,000, or so much thereof
13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Juvenile
14 Accountability Incentive Block Grant Trust Fund to the
15 Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for awards
16 and grants to state agencies and units of local government,
17 including operational expenses of the Authority in support of
18 the Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant program.

19 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
20 2005.
