SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Department of Veterans' Affairs for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, as follows:

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1

Section 5. 26 Section 10. The following named sums, or so much thereof 27 as may be necessary, are appropriated from the General 28 Revenue Fund to the Department of Veterans' Affairs for the 29 objects and purposes and in the amounts set forth as follows: 30 GRANTS-IN-AID

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13 Section 15. The sum of \$842,500, or so much thereof as 14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 15 Fund to the Department of Veterans' Affairs for the payment 16 of scholarships to students who are dependents of Illinois 17 resident military personnel declared to be prisoners of war, 18 missing in action, killed or permanently disabled, as 19 provided by law.

20 Section 25. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as 21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Military 22 Family Relief Fund to the Department of Veterans' Affairs for 23 the payment of benefits authorized under the Survivor's 24 Compensation Act.

25 Section 30. The following named amounts, or so much 26 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated 27 to the Department of Veterans' Affairs for objects and 28 purposes hereinafter named:

20 Section 40. The sum of \$3,310,800, or so much thereof as 21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Anna Veterans' 22 Home Fund to the Department of Veterans' Affairs for ordinary 23 and contingent expenses of Illinois Veterans' Home at Anna.

24 Section 45. The sum of \$13,000, or so much thereof as 25 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Anna Veterans' 26 Home Fund to the Department of Veterans' Affairs for refunds.
